TAXES:

In March 2019, the Nunda Township Board decreased your tax burden once again by abating \$100,000. This represents approximately 10% of the 2019/2020 Town Fund Levy.

In recent years we have lowered your Town Fund taxes as well:

9 % total reduction in fiscal year 2018/2019

14.5% total reduction in fiscal year 2017/2018

Our Township Board is sensitive to taxes and strives to lower our portion whenever possible.

ATTENTION: For Nunda Residents who are unincorporated and are currently using Waste Management for garbage and recycling services.... The Nunda Solid Waste Contract went out to bid and has been awarded to Marengo Disposal (MDC) for the next 4 years. Waste Management has provided Nunda with exceptional service for the last 4 years and we sincerely appreciate that. We expect MDC will provide great service as well. MDC's initial goal is to leave you with the same cart plans and pickup day.

The general terms of the contract have remained the same, but the pricing structure is **even lower than our current pricing**. The contract begins May 1, 2019, which will be the first pick up day by MDC. You should expect new MDC carts to arrive about a week before the switch. Waste Management will begin removing their carts after their last pick up in the week leading up to April 30. April 30 will be the last pick up day for Waste Management. Remember to leave your Waste Management carts at the curb and they will be removed within a day or two after they are emptied.

Service with MDC includes:

1. Weekly service for refuse and recycling using provided carts
2. Weekly service for 1 bulk item OR 1 cubic yard of home remodeling debris
3. Weekly service for unlimited yard waste from April 1st through the end of the first week of December
4. Annual document destruction day (held at Nunda in October)
5. Christmas tree pick up during January.
6. Curbside leaf vacuuming 3 times over 6-week period in the fall
7. White goods pick up and electronic recycling are available for an additional fee (must be pre-scheduled and pre-paid)

ROAD DISTRICT NEWS

As usual, we will be out to clean up our plow scars at the intersections. The sign Foreman is out straightening sign posts and replacing damaged signs. The asphalt crew will be out to replace the failing asphalt before they start our annual resurfacing projects. You can find our list of roads to be paved this year online at our website. Mailboxes and posts damaged during the winter will be repaired or replaced soon. We have an aggressive schedule for road maintenance this year. Weather can dictate how much we are able to complete. Don't forget to call the office to inspect your culvert if you plan to resurface your driveway this year.

SNOW PLOW SEASON

Our plows went out and completed 62 rounds this year. The average in the last 6 years was 40 rounds. We still have salt in inventory. Our plow drivers make every attempt to use the minimum amount of salt necessary to get the job done. Also, you will notice blue plows next season, this has been done to honor Sheriff's Deputy Jacob Keltner.

TRUCK AND EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE

All year long our mechanic and crews work diligently to maintain the equipment. We thoroughly inspect and repair equipment as needed to reduce the chance of breakdowns.

FLOOD RELIEF

Sandbags are available for flood control related needs. We do not generally have them filled in stock. Please call as far in advance as possible to allow us time to fill bags.

SEASONAL EMPLOYMENT

Nunda Road District is looking for seasonal help. This will be a laborer/truck driver position and requires a have CDL. Ideal candidate must be able to frequently lift 30 pounds, shovel asphalt and/or dirt and enjoy working in the outdoors. This temporary, seasonal job is one that requires great flexibility, as we do many menial tasks as well as truck driving.

MULCH

We will be delivering mulch to our seniors and Veterans again this year on Saturdays between the hours of 8am thru noon. Starting the first Saturday in April through the end of October, please call to schedule. We will continue our practice of loading mulch Saturdays 7am-12pm. Please be patient, if loader is unattended the operator will return within 20 minutes from making his delivery. If you want to load yourself, you may do so with your shovel at the Anita Sherwood Park on Pleasant Hill Road.

LEAVES

Leaves left in ditches cause drainage issues. They plug up drains and culverts then freeze in the winter, thus causing isolated flooding up stream of the blockage. If you get your leaves out after the pick-up date or an early snow storm hits, it is your responsibility to remove leaves from the right-of-way and drainage area. The system for leaf pick-up is consistently improving but cannot be counted on to take into account all possible situations.

“WE ARE NOT A DUMP. WE ARE NOT A DROP OFF FOR EVERYTHING.” We accept a limited variety of items. Residents **MUST** show ID or have a red “N” sticker displayed in window to use the facility. If you do not have an “N” sticker, please stop in at the Road District office and show ID to obtain it. If you do not see a sign for a specific item, please call or stop in at the office and ask.

Items accepted by Road District – 3518 Bay Road (From Residential residents of Nunda)

Oil (new and used), Lightbulbs, Brush / Tree Trimmings, Scrap Metal, Electronics, Large Batteries Only (truck, car, tractor), Tires (Saturdays & Sundays only 7am-3:30pm), Cardboard, Paper, Plastics (no plastic bags), Glass, Aluminum Cans, Used Clothing, Shoes, Textiles (in good condition), Latex and Oil Based Paints and Stains (from April 1 until Oct. 31)
