Now that Spring is here, we have some reminders and updates! Brush clean up from the February ice storm has been completed. If you still have debris, it can be dropped off at the Road District recycle center.

Nunda Road District has one of the best recycle centers in McHenry County, along with brush (**no leaves or grass clippings**), the following **CAN** be dropped off:

- Cans – Aluminum and Metal
- Glass Bottles and Jars
- Plastic Bottles and Jugs
- Newspaper, Cardboard, and Magazines
- Landscape, Brush, Sticks and Branches
- Scrap Steel
- Paint – Latex and Oil Base – *April 1st through October 31st*
- Electronics (**no T.V.'s or Monitors**)
- Light Bulbs
- Waste Oils
- Tires - *Saturdays Only 7am-12pm*
- Oil Recycling - *Nunda Township Road District accepts used motor oil for recycling all year around during regular business hours. Only waste oil will be accepted, no anti-freeze or other chemicals are allowed.*
- **NEW:** Clothes donation bins are back!



Car and truck batteries are accepted. All other batteries can be brought to [Batteries Plus](#) for recycling, some fees may apply.

## Volunteers always welcome at Nunda Garden!

The Nunda Garden enters its ninth year in 2023 providing fresh, nutritious produce to community members in need, as well as offering gardening education and volunteer opportunities. Located behind the Nunda Township office at 3510 Bay View Road, Nunda Garden is a one-acre site operated by McHenry County Master Gardeners from the University of Illinois Extension and community volunteers who grow and donate food. Last season Nunda Garden donated nearly 3,000 pounds of produce. Nunda Garden is also home to pollinator gardens and a new native garden.

Scheduled volunteer work hours are Monday, Wednesday and Saturday mornings, although many people come at other times to help as their schedules allow. Once the first crops are ready, distribution begins. This season Nunda Garden plans to donate to the Family Health Partnership, Holy Apostles Church, and the Illinois Migrant Council.

In addition to growing and distributing produce, the garden offers chances for community education and experiences for students needing service hours. Boy Scouts are currently building raised beds as part of an Eagle Scout program. A local Girl Scout troop plans to learn about food production from planting to consumption by helping at the garden.

Volunteers are needed for planting, weeding and harvesting produce, but we also welcome people who want to work on specific projects, such as delivering produce to recipients. This season we need help redoing our deer fence and replacing greenhouse panels that were damaged by hail.

The garden relies on donations of money and material, another way to help.

## MDC Contract Renewal

The Nunda Township Board of Trustees, after careful consideration with residents best interest in mind, voted to renew the current MDC Environmental Services residential solid waste, recycling and landscape waste collection contract for another four years.

However, in order to keep current services (including leaf vacuuming) and with the current economic conditions, prices have increased. Please keep in mind that rates were only increased once during the last contract period. **The new rates begin April 1st and are as follows:**
