Old Business

- Discussion was held on phone systems and internet service. Supervisor Shorten reviewed proposals from Comcast and Clarity. Consensus indicated Clarity may provide better continuity and lower cost across township offices. A final decision will be considered after additional review.
- Sherwood Park was discussed, with a proposed walkthrough to be scheduled before the next meeting to review drainage issues and potential use of the property.

- Office consolidation discussions remain ongoing and will continue into the fall.

Reports by the Supervisor, Town Clerk, Highway Commissioner, Assessor, Trustees and Cemetery Board Trustees:

Supervisor Shorten reported on the transition of township accounts to Home State Bank, updates on General and Emergency Assistance, completion of FOIA/OMA training requirements, and activities of the newly formed Cemetery Board. He also discussed investment restructuring, which has already generated additional interest income, and efforts to improve process efficiency in aid applications.

Commissioner Parish reported on the successful sale of unused equipment, acquisition of a loader, and preparation of another auction. He described a successful Touch-A-Truck event, ongoing road and bridge work, fleet maintenance, and recycling center improvements.

Trustee Halasz noted positive resident feedback about township roads and services.
